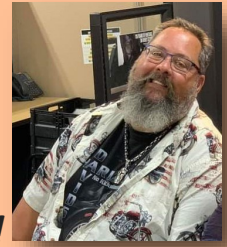

Embrace the Heat (Safely!)

Let's be honest, Southern California summers can get toasty. But that doesn't mean we have to park our beloved machines. It just means we need to be smart about how we ride. Here are a few reminders to keep you cool and safe out there:

- * **Hydration is Key:** Carry plenty of water and take frequent breaks to rehydrate. Consider electrolyte drinks for longer rides.
- * **Dress for the Occasion:** Lightweight, breathable riding gear is your friend. Mesh jackets and pants can make a huge difference. Don't forget sunblock and a good pair of riding glasses!
- * **Beat the Clock:** Early morning and late afternoon/early evening rides are often the most pleasant when the sun isn't at its peak.
- * **Know Your Limits:** Don't push yourself too hard in the heat. If you're feeling fatigued, pull over and take a break in the shade.

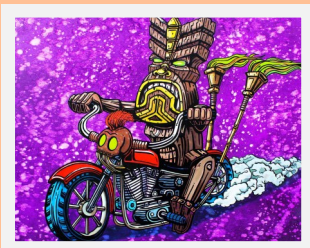
Get Ready for Our Overnight Adventure to Solvang!

Hello fellow Biggs HOG members. Well, the year is half over and we've had some really great rides so far with a few rides rained-out. We have some great rides coming up in the near future and little to no rain expected until the end of the year, so we can all plan to get out and RIDE!!

Now that the weather is getting warmer, we hope to see many more members on weekend rides as well as our Overnight and Long Distance Trips.

Road Guards

We are still looking for members to become Road Guards. For those who ride regularly, you know and rely on the work the Road Guards do to manage the rides to keep the groups together and as safe as possible so we all get to the destinations and then home so we can ride again another day. This is only possible when members step up and further serve our Chapter as Road Guards.

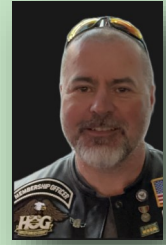
The Road Guard in Training (RGiT) program takes about nine months to complete under the watchful supervision of the other Road Guards, the Road Captain, and the Road Guard Panel. RGITs are identified by the Green Hats and Shoulder Ropes. They gradually learn how to manage the groups as Leads, Mid-Packs, and Sweeps. Throughout the training period there are three Classroom Training Sessions as well as several Training Rides where your skills are evaluated with feedback provided to help you improve. Once all of your training requirements are completed, there is a final "Evaluation Ride." Successful completion of this results in you becoming a Road Guard and you are presented with your Orange Road Guard Shoulder Rope, Hat, and Road Guard Patch. Once qualified, you never stop learning. You will continue to learn and improve.

Those interested need to submit an application. We are looking to start a new RGiT class later this year but no later than January 2026. One important benefit to completing this training and serving as a Road Guard is that you will become a much safer rider, even when riding alone. You will become more aware of your surroundings, other traffic, and road hazards. Contact the Road Captain if you are interested.

Beating the Heat While Riding



Greetings, Biggs HOG family! Summer is here, and with San Diego's diverse terrain—from coastal cruises to mountain twisties to desert adventures—we need to be smart about beating the heat while we ride.

Hydration Is Survival

Your body loses water through perspiration faster than you realize, especially in gear. Dehydration impairs judgment, reaction time, and coordination - exactly what we can't afford on two wheels. Start hydrating 2-3 hours before departure and pack more water than you think you need. Bring electrolyte supplements for long rides, and here's the key: drink before you feel thirsty and take frequent hydration breaks. Monitor your urine color - aim for pale yellow.

Smart Gear Choices

Here's a counter-intuitive truth: exposed skin feels cooler but actually heats up faster. The sun's UV rays heat your skin while wind evaporates sweat, creating a false sense of cooling. Light-colored, vented riding jackets work better than going without. Moisture-wicking base layers, mesh panels for airflow, and cooling vests for extreme heat are your friends. Avoid dark colors that absorb heat, non-breathable synthetic materials, and cotton that stays wet with sweat.

Route Planning for Heat

San Diego's summer reality check: coastal areas at 70°F by 8am can hit 85°F by 11am. Inland valleys commonly reach 95°F+ by noon, and desert areas require extreme precautions at 110°F+. For mountain rides, start early - temps drop 3-5°F per 1,000 ft. of elevation. Coastal routes may start cool but heat up fast when the marine layer burns off. Desert adventures need shade stops every 45-60 minutes. Plan fuel, food, and rest stops at air conditioned locations.

Know the Warning Signs

Heat exhaustion includes heavy perspiration (or no perspiration), weakness, fatigue, dizziness, nausea, headache, muscle cramps, and cool, clammy skin. Heat stroke is an emergency: high body temperature (103°F+), altered mental state, confusion, hot dry skin OR profuse sweating, rapid pulse, and loss of consciousness. Watch your riding partners for erratic behavior, frequent stops, or inability to keep pace—heat affects judgment before riders realize they're in trouble.

Emergency Action Plan

If someone shows heat distress, don't wait for permission to help. Move them to shade immediately, remove excess gear, apply water to skin if available, and create airflow. Give small sips of water if conscious, but NO water if unconscious or vomiting. Watch for improvement in 10-15 minutes and prepare to call 911 if no improvement. Call 911 immediately if someone is unconscious, confused, vomiting, unable to drink, shows no improvement after cooling efforts, or has a body temperature above 103°F.

Remember, Safety Is No Accident!

Stay cool, stay hydrated, and I'll see you all out on the road!

We're 93 members strong! We have an active core of riders ready to explore Southern California's incredible roads at any time. About 30% of our members are regularly active in meetings, volunteering, and weekend rides, while another 10-15% enjoy our Overnight adventures and multi-day Long Distance rides we offer throughout the year.

Rides for Every Style

Whether you're new to group riding or a seasoned road warrior, we have something for you. Our short rides (30-40 miles) explore the beautiful area from Valley Center to the coast and Temecula down to Poway - perfect for getting comfortable with group dynamics. 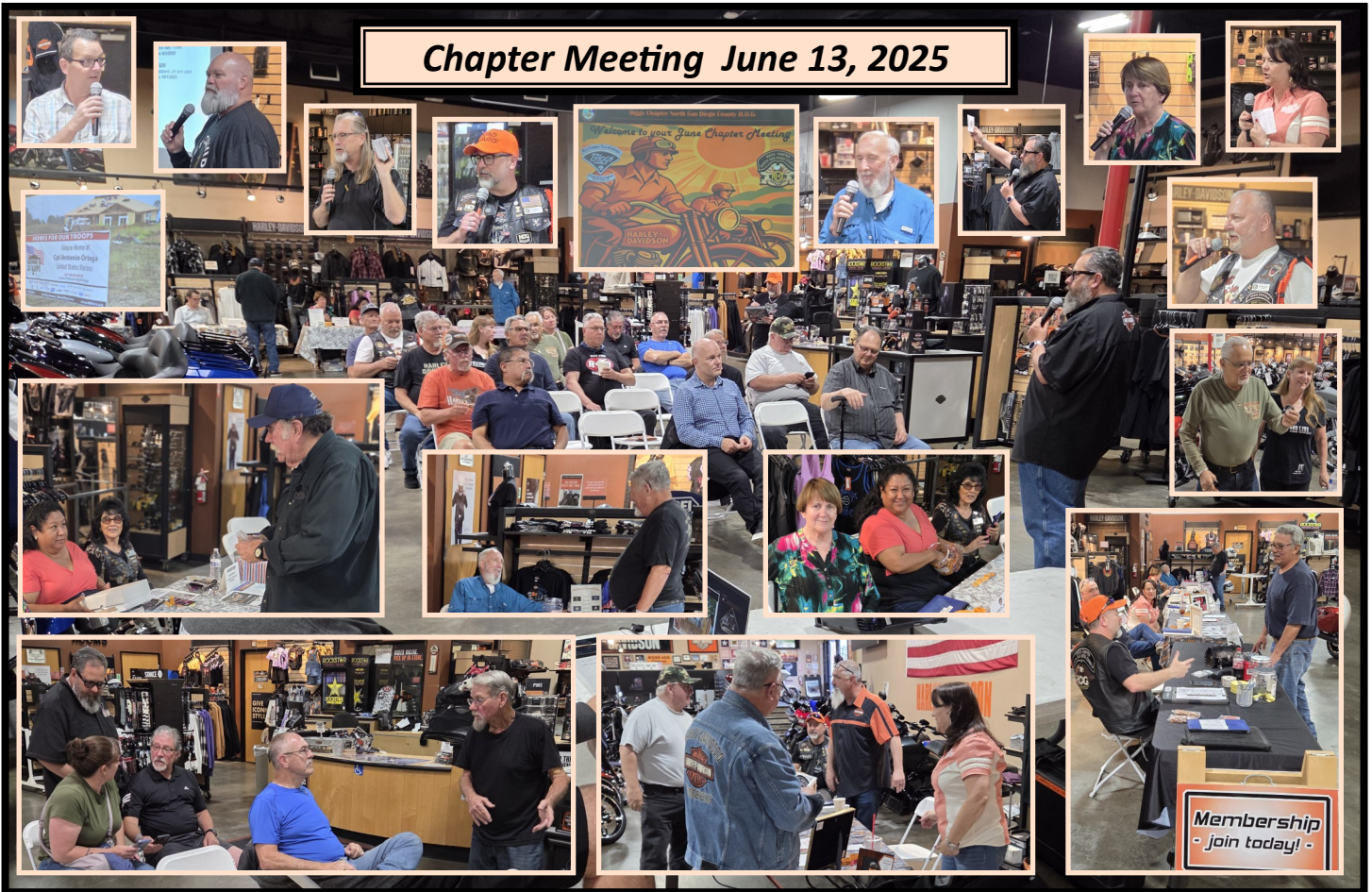
