Fun, food Adult Beverages and live music! Every Saturday in the Pig Pen. Come and get to know the staff in a social setting.



Several members will travel to and from the event on their own. Rooming arrangements are the responsibility of individual attendees. Some members are staying at the Casino and others are at various hotels in the Paris, Texas area.

For those interested, the "HOG" ride will be led by Pig Trail Road Captains. We will meet on Friday, October 4, 2019, at Workman's Plaza in Lowell (exit 78 on I49). Be there at 8:00 AM if you want to have some breakfast. We will have ride announcements and KSU at 9:00 AM with full tanks and empty bladders. Members will show their cards. Guests (with Harleys) are welcome to join the ride and we will have waivers for them to sign. Our plans are to ride to Mena, AR and stop for a "fast food" lunch and gas top off. After lunch we will take the Talimena Scenic Route and eventually end up in Paris, Texas.

On Saturday, October 5, bike line-up starts at 7:00 AM at Love Civic Center, 2025 South Collegiate Drive, Paris, TX 75460. Participants will be responsible to get to the Civic Center parking lot(s) on their own. There will be several thousand bikes and, unfortunately, we won't be able to stay together as a group during the parade.

For those interested, we plan to leave on Sunday, October 6<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 AM (full tanks and empty bladders) and take the quickest route back to Lowell, AR. We will depart from the Holiday Inn Express, 3025 NE Loop 286, Paris, TX 75460.
