

HD 120th Homecoming - Milwaukee

Day 1 - Saturday

Route: Flying J to Texarkana

KSU 7:30am

310 miles

- First gas stop is at 102 miles at Zavala - Chevron. It's in the "V" of 63 and 147.
- Possible lunch stop – San Augustine – Heart of Texas grill - open at 10:00am (Mile 133) or wait until Shreveport (restaurant choices waypoint – mile 207) Several to choose from near this waypoint.
- Second gas stop is 120 miles from last gas stop at the exit for Bossier City HD. Turn right off exit to Circle K.
- Stop at Bossier City HD dealer then 85 miles to hotel.

Day 2 - Sunday

Route: Texarkana – Branson

360 miles

- First gas stop is at 82 miles, in Cove, AR. Sunoco on left.
- Oklahoma - 1 Nation, 50 States checkpoint - route includes the OK Talimena Checkpoint.
- Second gas stop at Jif-E-Mart on right, in Waldron, AR (107 miles from last gas stop). Subway and Mexican next door to gas or wait another 55 miles to Ozark Burger Company (Lots of food choices at Ozark Burger Co.).
- Arkansas - 1 Nation, 50 States checkpoint - Arkansas Pig Trail Byway sign. It's about 8 miles north of Ozark on the route.
- Enjoy the twists and turns of the Pig Trail Byway.
- Third gas stop is at Shell on the right in Huntsville, AR (106 miles from last gas stop)
- Stop on route at Eureka Springs Harley (open Sunday)

Day 3 - Monday

Route: Branson - Quincy

310 miles

- First gas stop is at 90 miles at Lebanon exit 129. Phillips 66 on the right after off ramp.
- Missouri -1 Nation, 50 States checkpoint - route includes a 2 mile off course stop at the "Welcome to Bagnell Dam Billboard" (Lake of the Ozarks). If you don't want to stop just delete that waypoint.
- Second gas is at Jefferson City - exit Hwy "C" (90 miles from last gas stop)
- Third gas/bio break is 70 miles from last gas stop (if needed) Casey's in Laddonia

Day 4 – Tuesday

Route: Quincy – Prairie du Chien

335 miles

- Mississippi rivers views – will cross the Mississippi River 4 times today.
- Had to add a fair number of waypoints to the route to keep us on Mississippi river roads – sorry!
- Nauvoo historic city from 1840's. Rest rooms available at tourist info center waypoint.
- 1st gas at 85 miles. Burlington, IA - Casey's General Store on left
- 2nd gas stop is 110 miles further. Clinton, IA -Shell on right.
- Stop at Field of Dreams.
- Hotel overlooks the river.

Day 5 – Wednesday

Route: Prairie du Chien – Milwaukee

285 miles

- Will cross the Mississippi river twice today.
- Enter Minnesota for about 20 miles so you can cross that state off your list.
- Ride through picturesque LaCrosse, WI
- 1st gas is at 103 miles Viroqua – Kwik Trip on the left
- Ride rolling hills of SW Wisconsin
- Ride along the Wisconsin river
- Lunch stop at Wisconsin Riverside restaurant (on the Wisconsin river)
- 2nd gas is 122 miles past the last gas stop next to HD of Madison
- Stop at dealership - HD of Madison.
- Stop at dealership Wisconsin Harley – Oconomowoc
- Arrive at the hotel and enjoy a Spotted Cow beer!

Day 6 - Thursday

Route: Milwaukee - Thursday

51 miles

- Leave hotel 9:15
- Drive by and possible photo op at the original factory and current HD HQ on Juneau St.
- Arrive HD Museum for tour and explore all the events on the grounds. (Need your National #)
- Group photo with Chapter flag at museum
- Lunch at RiverFront Grill and Pizza on the Milwaukee River (2-mile ride from museum)
- Stop at Fonzi statue
- Cruise the Lake Michigan shoreline and Lincoln Memorial Drive (will pass Veteran's Park).
- Cross the Hoan Bridge (MKE landmark)
- Head to dealership – House of Harley
- HOG 40th Anniversary celebration (State Fair Park)
- Back to the hotel

Day 7 - Friday

Route: Milwaukee - Friday

97 miles

- Depart hotel at 8:30
- Ride past the HD Research and Design Center (No public admission)
- Arrive at the HD Powertrain factory for tour
- Meet Robert Casey's group at the factory for group photo
- Watch Police bike competition at the factory (Houston PD won last time!)
- Lunch at Jo Mama's on some scenic roads north of Milwaukee
- Stop at Holy Hill church for scenic views
- Ride a few back roads on our way to Milwaukee Harley dealership
- Head to Brady Street downtown MKE for an evening of people and bike watching. (Think Sturgis main street without the craziness)
- Head to Leon's frozen custard
- Back to hotel
- If interested, fireworks at a local festival/park about 5 miles from the hotel

Day 8 – Saturday**Route: Milwaukee – Springfield, IL****280 miles**

- The morning and early afternoon is free to explore any other events
- Block party in Wauwatosa starts at 11:00am.
- Depart for Springfield, IL

Day 9 – Sunday**Route: Springfield, IL – Bryant, AR****460 miles**

- Heading south toward home
- First gas stop is at 115 miles – Circle K just south of St. Louis
- Second gas stop is 130 miles from last stop - Exxon in Popular Bluff
- Third gas stop is 100 miles from last stop - Exxon in Newport
- No lunch recommendations – on your own.
- Mostly interstate

Day 10 – Monday**Route: Bryant, AR – Home****385 miles**

- Heading home
- First gas stop is 121 miles – Exxon in Texarkana
- Second gas stop is 80 miles from last stop – Exxon in Marshall
- Third gas stop is 81 miles from last stop – Sunoco south side of Nacogdoches
- No lunch recommendations – on your own.
- Sleep in your own bed
- Wash the bike
